

June meeting. Further nominations may be made from the floor at said meeting. Prior to any members elected to office assuming his/her duties their eligibility in The American Legion must be verified by the Executive Committee and proof of service must be on file. Installation of Post officers shall be held between September 1st and October 31st, both dates inclusive.

Section 4. All vacancies existing in any office of the Post with the exception of the office of the Commander, for any cause other than expiration of term, shall be filled by a majority vote of the Executive Committee, and a person so appointed shall hold office for the unexpired term of the officer who he/she succeeds. A vacancy shall exist when any officer is absent from his/her Post for a continuous period considered detrimental to the interest of the Post by the Executive Committee.

ARTICLE III

Post Executive Committee

Section 1. The Post Executive Committee shall meet for organization and such other business as may come before it at the call of the Post Commander within thirty (30) days after the installation of the new officers. Thereafter the Post Executive Committee shall meet at the call of the Commander as often as said Commander may deem necessary. The commander shall call a meeting of the Post Executive Committee upon joint request of three (3) or more members of said Post Executive Committee. A majority of the members of the committee shall constitute a quorum thereof.

Section 2. The Post Executive Committee shall hire such employees as may be necessary; shall authorize and approve all expenditures, shall require adequate bonds from all persons having custody of Post funds; and generally, shall have charge of and be responsible for the management of the affairs of the Post.

Section 3. Any member of the Executive Committee absent from three (3) consecutive meetings of the Executive Committee without notice of absence having been received by the Secretary of the committee in advance, shall automatically cease to be a member of the Executive Committee, and his/her place shall be filled by an election for the Post at the next regular business meeting of the Post.

ARTICLE IV

Duties of Officers

Section 1. It shall be the duty of the Post Commander to preside at all meetings of the Post and to have general supervision over the Chief Executive Officer of the Post. He shall approve all orders directing the disbursement of funds and shall make an annual
